At Job World, you can learn about all the jobs you could do when you are older. When you go, you can earn or lose dollars from different

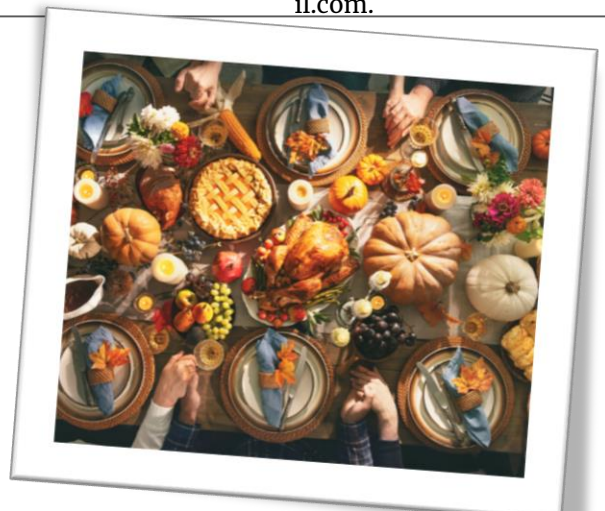
jobs. At the end of playing, you can buy certain things or save your dollars for the next time you go to Job World.
